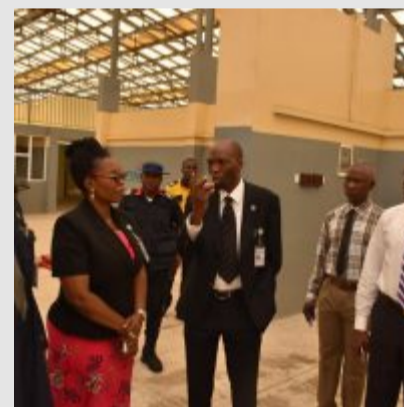
[KW-IRS Light up Ayedun](#)
