Automobile Registration Commence In Edu/Patigi LGA

KW-IRS Generates N7.7 Billion in Four Months

Kwara State Internal Revenue Service KW-IRS has generated the sum of N7.7 Billion (Seven Billion, Seven Hundred Million Naira) as Internally Generated Revenue(IGR) in the first four months of 2018 compared to N7.4 Billion (Seven Billion, Four Hundred Million Naira) recorded in the first four months of 2017 as against N11 Billion targeted.[Read more](#)
